- a) **Must** have been a member of YABA/USBC for at least (3) years and a member in good standings.
- b) **Must** be a High School Junior / Senior, or a College student enrolled in a under graduate program the year the scholarship is awarded. Graduate work is not eligible.
- c) **Must furnish** a complete high school transcript of grades 9 - 12. If in college, a complete updated transcript of all college credits earned to date.
- d) Submitted application **must be postmarked no later than March 15th.**

1. The Georgia State USBC Youth Association may award at least one (1) scholarship of \$1000.00 to a boy or girl who meets the eligibility requirements.
 2. Additional scholarships may be awarded based on funds available from the Georgia State USBC BA, Georgia State USBC Women's Assn. and the Georgia State Bowling Council.
 3. The number of scholarship(s) to be awarded shall be approval of the Georgia State USBC Youth Board of Directors. At least one (1) scholarship but no more than (8) eight scholarships in the same year but not necessarily every year.
 4. The Scholarship Committee shall consist of not less than (5) five members of the Georgia State USBC Youth Board, one of the five being an officer. Additionally, one educator and one religious leader may be added to the committee.
 5. The Scholarship committee will meet to evaluate each applicant's academic ability as indicated by transcript, bowling participation, hardship, and recommendations based on the information submitted. Individuals with Highest Combined Point Total will be the recipients of the scholarship aid. The decision of the Scholarship committee is final.
 6. Scholarships awarded from: GS USBC Youth, GS USBC WBA, and GS BC will be administrated by the Association Manager of the Georgia State Youth Association. Scholarship funds will be available for use within (4) four years of selection. Recipients are required to furnish information requested and the Scholarship funds will be mailed directly to the school within 30 days of the request. In the event the scholarship is not used, it will revert back to the Georgia State USBC Youth Association.
 7. The GS USBC BA awarded scholarships will be administrated by the Association Manager of the BA Association. Scholarship funds will be deposited in a SMART account prior to August 1 of the current year. In the event the scholarship is not used, it will revert back to the Georgia State USBC Bowling Association.
 8. All applications must be **mailed** to the Scholarship Chairperson. (US Mail ONLY)
 9. Applicants may re-apply in a subsequent year.
 10. Recipient(s) will be notified by mail. Scholarships will be presented at the Georgia State USBC Youth Awards Dinner in July.
